# Overview of the adaptation plans in the Asia-Pacific

This factsheet provides an overview of adaptation plan documents submitted to the UNFCCC by Asia-Pacific countries, and the in-depth analysis of these documents. While some countries have updated their NDCs and NCs multiple times, no countries have updated their adaptation-specific documents such as NAPs, so only the latest documents from each country are included in this analysis. The original data produced in this analysis can be downloaded in excel format from the AP-PLAT website.



## Status of the submitted documents to the UNFCCC including adaptation plans

## Analysis of the latest NC/NDC/NAP/AC in the Asia-Pacific

A detailed analysis of the adaptation plan documents was conducted by referring to the most recent documents from the NC/NDC/NAP/AC submitted to the UNFCC, one for each country. The table shows the composition of the referred documents. Since no country had NAPA that corresponded to the most recent document, it was not included in the documents analyzed.












# Priority sectors in adaptation plan documents






## Implementation strategy in adaptation plan documents




## Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) component in adaptation plan documents

The adaptation plan documents' contents indicating the M&E system were analyzed. The graphs show the number of countries including M&E system in their adaptation plan documents, by sub-region and category under the UN framework.



#### Financial support for adaptation plan development and its implementation

The number of countries with financial supports related to the development or implementation of adaptation plans were analyzed. Programmes under the UNFCCC and programmes of international organizations/MDBs were identified from the respective websites. Projects supported by the bilateral donor agencies were identified from the adaptation plan documents of the respective countries. If there are at least 1 project/programme supported by respective donors in the country, it is counted as 1 donor. The following figure shows the composition of the number of donors counted in the all countries in the Asia-Pacific.
