

## Workshop on the Compound and Cascading Disaster Risk Management Bangladesh

### Session Outline:

Ministry of Environment, Japan (MOEJ) intends to enhance the knowledge of severe effects of climate change and ways to build resilience and hence they are to facilitate localizing Compound and Cascading Disaster Risk Management (CCDRM) based on the experiences, needs, and challenges faced by the communities in developing Asia. As the whole world is constantly facing multi-hazards every minute, cascading and compound disasters are all we will be dealing in near future especially after Covid-19. Since Bangladesh is one of the countries increasingly exposed to extreme hazards involving compound and cascading disaster impacts, MOEJ intends to develop Local Guidebook on CCDRM in Bangladesh based on a consultative process with key stakeholders as well as interaction with communities affected by multiple hazards.

For that purpose, we intend to organize a daylong workshop with key stakeholders to discuss the scope and potential uses of the CCDRM guidebook at the local level. Which will be developed in English and Bengali language. The guidebook as well as other key outcomes will be shared through partners organization website including AP-PLAT.

The seminar will be led by the Postgraduate Programs in Disaster Management (PPDM) Brac University in collaboration with the Department of Disaster Management DDM of the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief (MoDMR) Bangladesh; the Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES); and the Ministry of Environment Japan and the Community Development for Peace (CDP), Bangladesh.

A number of professionals, practitioners and academicians have been invited to participate in the workshop.
